

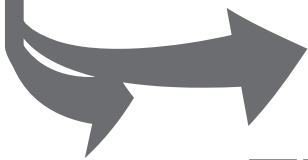


EVERY FAMILY HAS A STORY.

You may often pick up a local newspaper or magazine and wonder why there is not an ad for MPCCS included. Why are there not commercials on the nightly news telling the story of MPCCS? This is intentional. We sincerely believe that our story is *not* told by one or two photographs, pithy one-liners, or brief sound bites. Simply put, the Mount Paran Christian School's story is told best by *you* in the neighborhood, at church, in the grocery store, and at work. You made a decision to prayerfully partner with us, and you asked us to play a role in the educational, spiritual, and social experience of your family. Thank you for the high trust that accompanies that decision.

Now, we are asking you to continue to do what you do best and share your family's MPCCS story with friends, colleagues, and church members. There is no better way to grow the MPCCS family; our statistics and experiences are clear on that fact. To say "thanks" for your willingness to share, we are launching "Family to Family." **Family to Family's purpose is to recognize those who share their MPCCS story by providing a "family referral credit" in the amount of \$100 to the account of any current family for each new family they successfully recruit to MPCCS.**



THIS IS HOW "FAMILY TO FAMILY" WORKS:

- The name of only one current family may be listed on the designated referral line of the application at the time the application is submitted.
- One hundred dollars per NEW family would be applied as a tuition credit to the current MPCCS family listed as the referral family.
- Only NEW FAMILIES (not current MPCCS families) who seek enrollment may be referred. New siblings of current families are not included as they are not from a new MPCCS family.
- The new family must have at least one student who is accepted under standard admission policies, completes registration, becomes a "current student" through financial and contractual obligations, and attends MPCCS under standard terms of agreement.
- For each completed, validated referral, a tuition credit of \$100 will be applied to the account of the current MPCCS family on October 1, 2010.
- There is no cash value for the credit.
- There is no limit to the number of credits a current family may receive as long as they are validated through the eligibility requirements.
- If a family has credits over and above their tuition for the 2010-11 school year, the credits will be applied to the following year.
